### Paullina Hardware 104 Broadway, Paullina



#### Solsma's Punkin Patch 6190 320th St., Sanborn






### The Cobblestone Bar 133 1st St. SE. Primghar

### Breu Haus Coffee & Brewery 1220 2nd Ave., Sheldon




